

Hike Simplon elevated route

Description

Day 1

The pass has been used by people as a crossing point for centuries. The oldest archaeological finds on the Simplon Pass date from the Neolithic period, with a few from the Mesolithic period. Kaspar Stockalper, Napoleon and also the two world wars have left their mark on the pass.

The path leads us away from the many hikers on the Stockalper Trail, from the pass in a southerly direction. From an elevated position, we look out over the historic buildings of the Simplon Pass and learn a lot about the history of the Simplon. Our hike ends in Simplon village.

Requirements

T2 according SAC Table

Walking time : around 6 h
Distance : around 17km
Altitude metres : ↗ 704m; ↘ 1231m
The hike can also be shortened to approx. 4 hours

Meals : from your backpack
Number of persons : unlimited
Meeting point : Simplon-Pass (Rest. Simplonblick)
