

Hike Val de Moiry VS

Description

Day 1

The Val de Moiry is an exceptional valley in the canton of Valais. Wild, rustic and unspoilt, it shows its most beautiful side. Zinal is the starting point for the hike. The trail leads us over the Corne de Sorebois at 2,895 metres above sea level. Once on the ridge, the Val de Moiry opens up below us with the gigantic Lac de Moiry reservoir.

Every step brings us closer and closer to the Glacier de Moiry and the hut. The hut soon comes into view. One last steep climb and we are standing in front of the hut. The glacier seems close enough to touch. Unbelievable, our nature.

The hall of the hut has a large window front. Enjoying dinner opposite the glacier and sitting together in a cosy atmosphere is an unforgettable experience. Goosebumps.

Day 2

For a brief moment, we follow the path back down to the valley floor. At Lac de Châteaupré, we take the path heading west towards the Col du Tsaté. This lies at 2,867 metres above sea level and opens the window to the Val d'Hérens. A leisurely descent to Les Haudères. From there we take the bus back to Sion.
